Hawaiian assets welcome Year of the Dragon

Traditional Chinese Dancers will visit at a number of Hawaiian properties, performing a Dragon Dance to welcome in the Chinese New Year 'Year of the Dragon'.

The Chinese New Year, which commences on Monday 23 January 2012, is the longest and most important celebration on the Chinese calendar, with festivities continuing over a period of 15 days.
